Sir,

The State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) has reviewed the Environmental Clearance accorded to the Pappu Valley HEP (48 MW) in view of the guidelines communicated by the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India from time to time. Accordingly, I have been directed to inform you that the Environmental Clearance accorded to the Pappu Valley HEP (48 MW) vide No. FOR.(Env)-18/2010/EIA PVHEP/58-63 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2013 is hereby revoked.

Further, I have been directed to inform you that the competent authority in its meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2013 has decided to accord Environmental Clearance for the project. However, formal Environmental Clearance will be issued only after Stage-I forest clearance for the forest land involved in the project is obtained by you and submitted. Therefore, you are requested to submit Stage-I forest clearance within 12 (twelve) months for according Environmental Clearance. In case, the Stage-I forest clearance is not submitted within the prescribed time limit the proposal for Environmental Clearance will stand rejected and the entire process of obtaining Environmental Clearance will have to be initiated de-novo as per procedure prescribed in EIA Notification, 2006.


